**Task 1**

You are going to have a party.  
You want to bake some muffins rather than buying them.  
You find a recipe. Read the instructions.

**Muffins**

Makes 24 mini cakes or 12 larger muffins

For mini cakes you will need a 12 hole tartlet tin.

For larger cakes use a 12-hole bun tin.

Ingredients:

- 125g / 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz softened butter
- 125g / 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz caster sugar
- 2 eggs, lightly beaten
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 125g / 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz self-raising flour
- 2 tbsp milk

1. Preheat the oven to 190C/375F/Gas mark 5. Either butter the tin or place the paper cases in the holes. In a mixing bowl beat the butter and sugar until pale and fluffy. You can use an electric mixer or a wooden spoon.
2. Add in the beaten egg, a little at a time. Whisk it well. Then beat in the vanilla.
3. Tip in half the flour and fold into the mixture. Add the milk and the rest of the flour and fold until well mixed.
4. Spoon into the tin and bake for 12 minutes or until risen and golden on top. Allow to cool for ten minutes on a rack before removing from the tin.

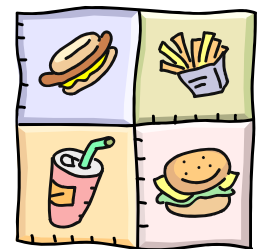
