Learning outcomes <i>The learner will:</i>	
1. Be able to agree the scope of a community project	
Delivery content: The purpose of this learning outcome is to ensure that learners can demonstrate that they are able to work with community organisations and colleagues to agree the scope of a community project. Learners must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • agree project brief with stakeholders. • be able to identify the requirements of the project brief that are within the skillset of the group. • identify additional works required to support the project that are outside of the group skillset. • agree access arrangements with community regarding welfare facilities etc. 	
2. Be able to plan a community project	
Delivery content: The purpose of this learning outcome is to allow learners to demonstrate their ability to plan a community project. Learners must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • work with others to agree on the work required. • calculate the time required to complete the project. • produce a work plan. • work with others to identify and organise stages of the project. • identify project milestones. • identify the tools, equipment and materials required for each stage. • ensure that tools, equipment and materials are available when required. 	

3. Carry out a community project

Delivery content:

The purpose of this learning outcome is to allow learners to demonstrate the skills and behaviours in working with others, including stakeholders to complete a community project.

Learners must:

- carry out safety checks to tools, equipment, materials and the working environment.
- undertake tasks as agreed to support completion of a community project.
- monitor delivery against milestones and report issues if work does not go to schedule.
- maintain a safe working environment.
- ensure that tools, equipment, materials and the environment are left safe and clean at the end of each session.

4. Be able to review a project

Delivery content:

The purpose of this learning outcome is to allow learners to review the project.

Learners must identify:

- own strengths in working with others.
- areas for future development when working with others.
- what went well with the project.
- what could have been done differently.

Scope of Training

The Scope of Training identifies areas that must be covered during the delivery of this unit. This is the minimum that is expected but tutors are expected to include other areas, knowledge of which will benefit their learners, based on location, types of work available and from the tutors own professional experience.

Scope of Assessment

What would you expect the learner to be able to do or not to do?

The purpose of this unit is to provide learners with the opportunity to deliver a community project working alongside other learners. The project is centre set and can involve learners within the same discipline working together or those from across a number of disciplines delivered by the training provider. It should allow learners to be involved in basic project planning and delivery under guidance from the tutor and must be suitable for their skills set. This unit allows for the development of their planning skills and evidencing of learner communication skills including verbal, listening and writing.
