Learning outcomes <i>The learner will:</i>	
1. Know how to agree the roles to be taken for a group project.	
Delivery content: The purpose of this learning outcome is to ensure that learners are aware of the different roles that make up a team and are able to agree with others who should take each role. The learner must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be able to identify the different roles needed within a team. • work with other learners to agree who will take on each role. 	
2. Be able to plan a project.	
Delivery content: The purpose of this learning outcome is to allow learners to demonstrate their ability to plan a project. The learner must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • work with others to agree the required plan. • work with others to break the task into manageable stages. • identify the tools, equipment and materials required for each stage. 	
3. Complete a construction project.	
Delivery content: The purpose of this learning outcome is to allow learners to demonstrate the skills and behaviours in working with others to complete a project. The learner must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be able to work with others to achieve the aims of the project. • be able to demonstrate appropriate teamworking and communication skills. 	

4. Be able to review a project

Delivery content:

The purpose of this learning outcome is to allow learners to review the project

The learner must identify:

- own strengths in working with others.
- areas for future development when working with others.
- what went well with the project.
- what could have been done differently.

Scope of Training/Assessment

What would you expect the learner to be able to do or not to do?

It is expected that tutors include other areas, knowledge of which will benefit their learners, based on location, types of work available and from the tutors own professional experience.
