



## Course Specification: Loadmaster Hazard Awareness (Construction)

NOCN Group have produced this assured course in association with Flannery Plant Hire and the Operator Skills Hub to promote safe plant vehicle loading / unloading practices in the construction industry. The outline, structure and content of this course is assured by NOCN group. The validation period for this course is 3 years.

### Course Approval

Prior to advertising or delivering this assured course, organisations must first gain 'centre approval' from NOCN as well as gaining approval for each individual SiteRight assured course. ### Trainer Requirements

All tutors / trainers and assessors must:

- hold verifiable knowledge of the occupational standards at or above the level being taught
- hold or be working towards a recognised teaching/training or assessor qualification (dependent on their role)
- keep up to date with industry best practice for the duration of their role
- hold an up-to-date CV.

In order to deliver the course, all trainers must also be able to evidence an in-depth understanding of plant and vehicle loading / unloading hazards within a professional capacity and have evidence of CPD. Evidence of attendance at previous vehicle loadmaster hazard awareness (construction) training is **mandatory**.

### Resource and Equipment Requirements

In order to deliver the course, the Centre must have access to and make use of the following resources and equipment:

Requirement	Detail
<b>Training environment</b>	Clean and dry training area with adequate tables, chairs & welfare facilities
<b>Delivery</b>	Laptop or desktop – Course delivery presentation Paper and pens Flipchart or whiteboard Delivery vehicle with an item of plant correctly loaded.
<b>Testing</b>	Test Paper per delegate.



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## Course Delivery

The course must consist of a maximum of 12 delegates unless pre-agreement is gained from NOCN. The basic course will be delivered over a 3.5-hour time period.

The course is theory-based and will be delivered via a presentation. The NOCN assured training resources must be used to deliver the training. To ensure that the most up-to-date material is being used, centres must download the material from [MyNOCN](#) each time, prior to delivery of a loadmaster hazard awareness (construction) course. All surplus training material must be destroyed after each occasion that a course has been run.

The structure of the training is provided by the course PowerPoint and a test paper, available on the [MyNOCN](#) online learning platform. Trainers are expected to use these resources to guarantee that delegates are witness to the total information required to successfully complete this course.

Due to the nature of this course NOCN require a delivery vehicle to be available with an item of plant loaded on it, as a visual practical aid.

## Assessment Material

Assessment material (knowledge test paper) must be printed immediately before the training course is delivered. Centres will need to retain the delegates assessment material for 3 years after the course has been completed. Any unused assessment material must be securely destroyed after the completion of the course. ## Multiple Choice Test Paper

The test paper is compulsory and consists of 14 questions covering various aspects of the course. The delegates are permitted 30 minutes to complete the assessment.

Once the test is over, the Trainer is required to mark the test paper against the mark scheme provided by NOCN. The assessment requires a score of **14** in order for the delegate to pass. Once the learner's mark has been calculated, the answer sheets should be retained as evidence for any future quality assurance audits.
