

Changes to NOCN_Cskills Awards Level 3 Construction Training Qualification Provision: Plastering – Fibrous

To ease the transition of learners from Level 2 Construction Training Qualifications to Level 3 Construction Training Qualifications, NOCN has provided options for centres. Traditionally learners have been able to carry forward unit achievements from level 2 qualifications and we have striven to continue this, where possible.

However, due to the restrictions brought by the moratorium (ESFA) on new qualifications we are limited in the types of changes that we can make so each trade area has been considered separately.

If your centre is approved to deliver any of the following level 3 qualifications look out for bulletins providing information on the progression from level 2:

There are now two routes within the qualification:

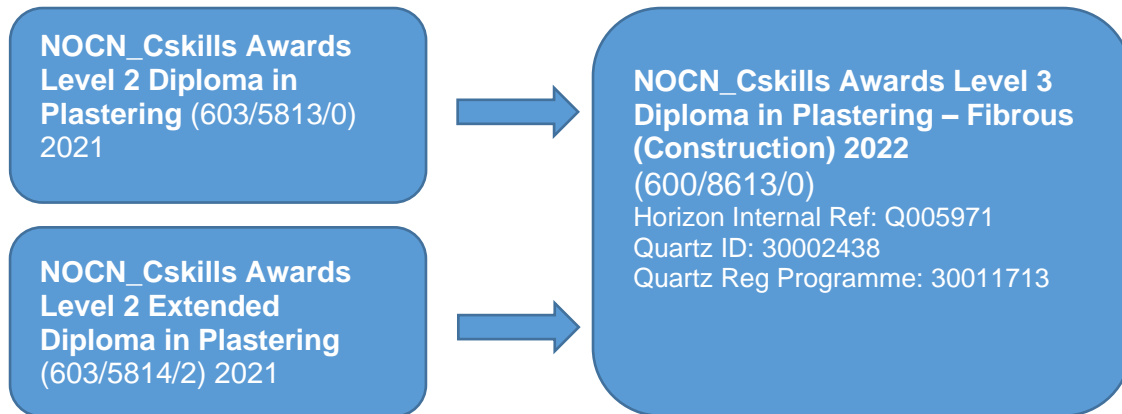
- Option 1:

 - NOCN_Cskills Awards Level 2 Extended Diploma in Plastering (603/5814/2) (2021)should progress onto:
 - NOCN_Cskills Awards Level 3 Diploma in Plastering – Fibrous (Construction) 600/8613/0 (2022) **Registration of learners - start date 1 September 2022**

These learners will be able to carry over the **Construction Health and Safety unit (F/618/0738)**
- Option 2:
Learners who have completed:
 - NOCN_Cskills Awards Level 2 Diploma in Plastering (Construction) (600/8612/9) (Legacy)should progress onto:
 - NOCN_Cskills Awards Level 3 Diploma in Plastering – Fibrous (Construction) 600/8613/0 (Legacy) Registrations of learners - start date August 2022

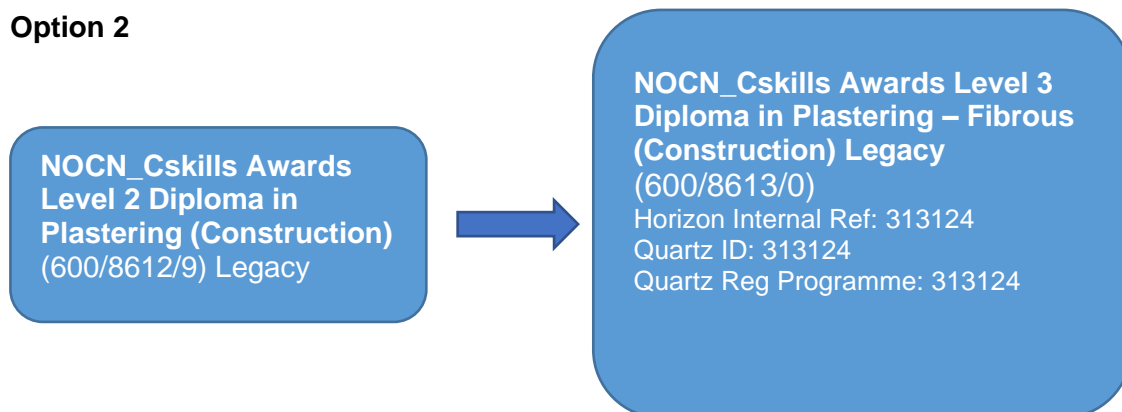
These learners will be able to carry over the **Health, Safety and Welfare in Construction and Associated Industries** unit (J/504/7856) from the level 2 qualification above.
