- *The kinds of photos you like to take*
- *Music you listen to*

Remember to take turns and speak clearly, give your opinions, ask and answer questions and listen carefully to the information and questions.



Task 3 - This task is for a small group discussion between 2 to 4 people

You have up to 5 minutes to prepare what you want to say.

Instructions for the candidates

You will talk about:

- spending money online.

You can talk about some these things....

- *Things you like / don't like about shopping online. Why / Why not?*
- *Things you can buy online*
- *Is shopping online safe*
- *Is it cheap or expensive*
- *The best online shopping websites*
- *Paying bills online*
- *Managing your money online, e.g. Bank Accounts*
- *Playing games online, e.g. The Lottery, Bingo or other games.*

Remember to listen to the other learners and take turns. Be polite and formal.
