You can talk about

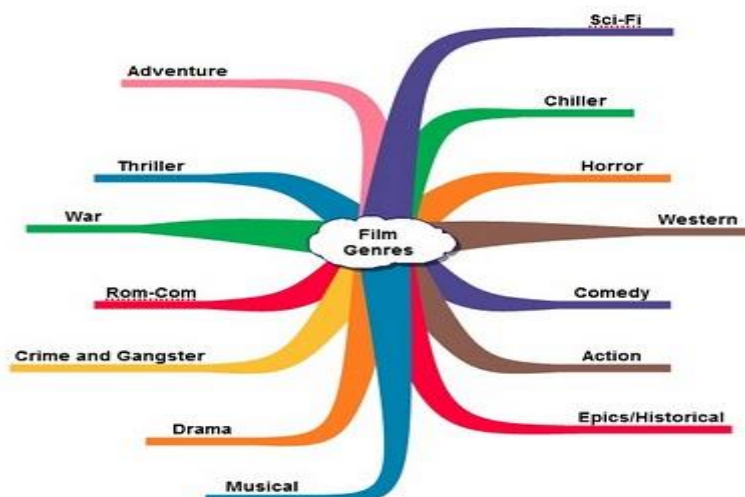
- *The kind of films you like to watch*
